NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above-captioned District will hold a public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 1400, Houston, Texas 77056, said address being an office and meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on *Tuesday, January 9, 2018, at 12:00 noon.*

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Review and approval of the minutes of December 12, 2017, Board of Directors meeting;
2. Public Comments;
3. Appointment of new Director and acceptance of Qualification Statement, Bond, Oath of Office and Election Not to Disclose Certain Information for new Director;
4. Election of Officers of the Board of Directors of the District;
5. Approval of District Registration Form relative to appointment of new Director;
6. Discussion regarding training requirements for new Director pursuant to the Texas Open Meetings Act and the Texas Public Information Act, and the procedures for compliance with same;
